

# Child Find Notice

Child Find is a comprehensive developmental screening assessment process, which identifies children, 3 to 21 years of age who have disabilities that may hinder their learning. Riverside School District No. 2 is responsible for locating, identifying, and evaluating all children with known or suspected disabilities who reside within our geographic boundaries to determine whether a need for special education and related services exists. This includes children attending private schools and homeschooled students.

If you are a parent or guardian of a student attending a private school within the district, or have a homeschooled student, or if you know a child that might be in need of services for a disabling condition please call the Riverside School District No.2 Exceptional Student Services Department at (602) 4777-8900, ext. 1337.
